



**ORDER**

Let a writ of habeas corpus ad prosequendum be issued to the Sheriff of Orleans Parish Prison in New Orleans, Louisiana, or one of his authorized deputies, ordering and directing said Sheriff of the said institution, or one of his authorized deputies, to surrender the body of **ROBERT DURST** to the United States Marshal for the Eastern District of Louisiana, or one of his authorized deputies, or to any other United States Marshal, or one of his authorized deputies, to be thereafter produced by said United States Marshal, on or before the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2015, at 2:00 p.m., before United States District Judge Lance M. Africk, to appear for initial appearance and arraignment pursuant to a complaint ~~after which **ROBERT DURST** is to remain in the custody of the U.S. Marshal until resolution of federal charges pending against him,~~ and thereafter be returned by the United States Marshal for the Eastern District of Louisiana, or one of his authorized deputies, or any other United States Marshal, or one of his authorized deputies, to Orleans Parish Prison in New Orleans, Louisiana, and there be surrendered to the Sheriff of said institution, or one of his authorized deputies.
